CELEBRATING 20 YEARS

9th Annual Gala kicks off 20 years of service

In March Clínica Amistad turned 20! We hosted our 9th annual gala dinner and 20th birthday celebration to kick off a year of recognition, celebration, and care for our community.

Our gala gives us the opportunity to publicly honor our board, providers, staff and volunteers — all the people who so diligently give their time and effort to provide free primary health care to those who need it the most. This year, we had the opportunity to honor our founders who had a vision of starting a free health clinic on the south side of Tucson. We are also honored Rick Small from the Stonewall Fund at The Community Foundation of Southern Arizona, who received the Clínica Amistad Community Impact Award and Southwest Gas, who received Clínica Amistad's Community Partner Award. Our recipients have tirelessly served our community for many years and have made an impact on Clínica Amistad.


Our Founders shared a profound concern about the lack of a true free clinic in Tucson that would meet the needs of those who could not afford preventive and primary care and envisioned this free clinic having seen a great need for medical services in the area, spearheaded a committee to establish the 501(c)3 known today is Amistad y Salud, which officially began in 2003. They strived to develop a model integrative health center, Clínica Amistad, where education, nutrition, and alternative therapies would be integrated into the care provided, rather than depend solely on medications.

Since its inception, Clínica Amistad's mission has been rooted in humanitarian perspectives. Clínica Amistad has demonstrated an innovative, changing approach to health service delivery for those individuals throughout southern Arizona who have "fallen through the cracks" of the national healthcare system. It has become a safety net helping to provide primary health care to patients who are under-served.

Today, 20 years later, the need for Clínica Amistad continues to grow. This past fiscal year we served over 1,350 individual patients and provided 2,400 appointments to our community. We are so grateful to all who attended and contributed to the gala in March and to those who make contributions throughout the year. Without your help we would not exist.


HOW YOUR SUPPORT MAKES A DIFFERENCE IN OUR COMMUNITY

KEY FACTS ABOUT WHO WE SERVE

In the fiscal year from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, with the clinic being open on Wednesday and Thursday evenings, and one Saturday morning every month; we held 2,370 appointments. We saw 1,343 individual patients with 226 of them being new to our clinic this year. There are 37 licensed healthcare providers who volunteer time at the clinic. Other volunteers number more than 110, with many being students in various healthcare fields at the University of Arizona and Pima Community College.


